'57 Chevy



Forty years without slumbering, tick tock, tick tock. But it was a '57 Chevy pickup, not a clock, that Bob McQueen bought for \$500. in 1977. Over the years, the originally chartreuse truck also went through a root beer color paint phase before donning the present metallic green coating. 'Ol Bob, as the truck is called, sports a number of body modifications acquired over the years.



The door handles have been shaved and you'll notice the clean looking hood. The antenna is frenched in just behind the passenger door. The bed is diamond plate, and there is a custom tail light treatment with lights also in the rolled ends of



the upper bed. Ghost flames hide in the green paint till you get the sun at the right angle, then they leap out at you. Chrome reverse wheels and baby moon caps, along with the visor and peep mirrors enhance the "old school" appearance.

The pickup sits on an El Camino front clip. The Elky also contributed the drive train, a 350 cid engine and a 400 trans, and power steering

The interior has been made right comfortable with a big Lincoln seat and custom steering wheel.
